THE LANGUAGE OF LOVE

Love has been a theme for many a poet or song writer. It is a universal human need and desire. Without love we perish. With love we seem to bloom and prosper. But, what exactly is love? Where does it come from? How is it best shared and demonstrated?

In a marvelous book, [The Five Love Languages](#), Dr. Gary Chapman describes the gift of love being expressed in five unique ways: time spent together, words of affirmation, acts of service, physical touch, and gift giving. His thesis is that everyone catches on to one aspect of the expression of love better than all the others. He calls it, “our primary love language”. Each of us needs to hear and experience love in the language we best understand.

With this in mind, our focus this Advent will be God’s wonderful and unique way of expressing His love for us through each of these love languages. As we learn to hear the language of love from our Lord, we will be better equipped to express our own love for one another.

This is the heart and theme of our Advent and Christmas celebration. “For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Begotten Son.” And, “As He has loved us, so we should love one another.” We pray that this season will be a time for you to grow in your appreciation of God’s special love for you, and your ability to share that love with each other.

the children and youth at Sunshine Acres.
